


### SAN MIGUEL DE ALLENDE

Founded in the 16th century, San Miguel de Allende is known for old world charm and first world amenities. A lively nightlife and abundance of fine restaurants give the mid-sized town a cosmopolitan vibrancy. The center of town is a time capsule of cobblestone streets lined with jewel tone colonial facades and stone colonnades, and overshadowed by La Parroquía, an immense neo-gothic church of pink stone. Nearby day trips include hot springs, high desert hikes, and the Jesuit Sanctuary of Atoltonilco, famous for its murals of angels and demons and over-the-top Mexican Baroque interior.

Immerse yourself in San Miguel de Allende's rich culture and history by exploring the vibrant Mercado de Artesanías, discovering Fabrica de Aurora's fascinating art galleries, and learning about Instituto Allende's history through Diego Rivera's famous murals.
